<p>Hope Services' Helping Individuals with Developmental Disabilities (DD) with Emergency Preparedness project focuses on widespread distribution of emergency preparedness information to their clients and their families. The project will provide essential emergency preparedness supplies to over 1,100 HOPE clients in Santa Clara, San Benito, Santa Cruz, and Monterey counties. People need to have adequate supplies on hand to shelter in place for 72 hours in the event of an emergency or natural or man-made disaster, as recommended by Collaborative Agencies' Disaster Relief Effort (CADRE), the American Red Cross, and all emergency planning agencies. The approximately 5 to 10% of our clients in these counties who live independently or in supported living arrangements need to have supplies at home.
