GENERAL BUSINESS:

Loretta Milne chaired the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 10:09 a.m. She then welcomed everyone to the April 13th, 2016 Regional Advisory Meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Rick Sowers was encouraged to introduce himself and his agency. He works for Vocation Plus Day Program. He has worked for Vocation Plus, which has 21 offices in the Central Valley, reaching from Bakersfield to Oakhurst for over 10 years. He is currently assigned to their corporate office located on Fulton Street in Fresno. He is the Client Outreach Director. He stated his intentions to apply for and join the Regional Advisory Committee. The Committee thanked him for his update and encouraged him to apply.

Mijha Leasure of Community Catalyst, an SLS program also introduced herself and her co-worker Esmeralda Lopez.

Former Area Board Member and public guest Kashy Rowland-Smith wanted to address her concerns with the Committee about the need in the community to train younger individuals and families to stay involved in legislation and the continuing fight for services and entitlement issues. Input was given by staff that this is a very large need in our community and that opportunities to connect experienced families and individuals with the more inexperienced were welcome. Marria Jones added that the Visalia Down Syndrome Society Parents Group is always looking for guest speakers or presenters to talk to families with young children on different topics.

COMMUNITY REPORTS:

The No Stigma Speakers Bureau of Tulare County attended and gave a presentation. There were 3 presenters, Michael Esquibel, Suzanne Leary and Kathy Sims, each of whom spoke of their life and experiences. They present all over Tulare County on topics including mental and physical issues, alcohol or drug abuse and how their life experiences have affected them. The program was designed to help individuals share their stories of Hope, Wellness & Recovery. Their Mission is to transform pain into empowerment through sharing with others our stories of lived experience.

STATE COUNCIL REPORT:

Rebecca Donabed gave a brief update on the March 8th, 2016 State Council on Developmental Disabilities Council Meeting. She reported that Aaron Bishop, the Commissioner from AIDD, was in attendance and expressed his appreciation for all the hard work State Council and the Regional Offices have put into the improvement of our agency. We are now 85% cleared and the next report is due to them on October 1st.

REGIONAL OFFICE MANAGER REPORT:

Yolanda Cruz, Regional Office Manager, updated the RAC on the Structural Budget Deficit for The State Council and Regional Offices. Handouts were distributed and discussed the findings of the Deficit Committee including the closure of the Regional

Central Coast Office. Also reviewed were the approved 6 State Plan Goals for the 2017-2021 plan as well as information on the planned closures of the Porterville and Fairview Developmental Centers.

The next Board meeting will be held on June 8th, 2016 at Central Valley Regional Center. Elections for Committee Chairs will be held at the August meeting, with candidates selected in June.


