SIGNIFICANT ITEMS

- Voted to support/oppose I/DD Bills
- Disability Spotlight – Cerebral Palsy
- Review of Draft SCDD 2018-19 Budget
- Created a Subcommittee on Policies and Procedures

UPDATES

- Self Determination Waiver submitted to the federal government
- Council sponsored legislation is focused on employment:
 - AB 2171 (Frazier) “One Person, One Goal”
 - SB 1274 (McGuire) Employment Data Sharing
- Assembly Speaker created a Select Committee on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities; SCDD is a technical advisor to the committee
- Testified in Budget hearings to advance Council’s priorities
- SCDD is actively participating in DD Awareness Month 2018 “See Me For Me”
- Cycle 41 Grants received 76 responses, the Council will review recommended proposals at May 2018 meeting
- Updated on implementation of structural deficit cost saving actions adopted by the Council
