

Employment Rates

13% of people with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD) who were interviewed in California say they have a job in the community.

Among the 13% of those employed in 14/15, people with I/DD tell us they are working in the following environments: N = 781


33% work in Integrated Competitive Employment

Engages in Moderate Physical Activity

The proportion of adults telling us that they exercise at least 30 minutes a day, 3 times per week. Moderate physical activity is defined as an activity that causes some increase in breathing or heart rate.

N = 8,345

Overweight or Obese

58%

58% of respondents were reported as being overweight or obese, meaning they have a Body Mass Index (BMI) of 25 or more. This measurement is based on reported height and weight. N = 8,165

Chose Where They Lived

Percentage of People who tell us they chose or had some input in choosing where they lived

N = 4,842


not staff or family This question could only be answered by
