Many bills are still in draft form (the bills listed under 8b in the Packet). LPPC will consider taking positions on these bills once the full-text is available.

Committee members used the Council approved Legislative Platform, Policy Priorities, and the Policy Framework to guide the discussion and subsequent recommendations before you today.

In addition to the five (5) position recommendations, the Committee will continue and watch and/or gather additional information on additional bills, many of these bills are listed in the Council packet.

SB 398 Durazo (D)	Codifies the existing federal authority of the protection and advocacy agency in the Lanterman Act. The authority allows Disability Rights California to immediately access state funded facilities, programs, or service providers to meet with the individuals and review their records to ensure the rights and safety of individuals with disabilities are being protected.
