

Policy Questions About the Regional Advisory Committees (RAC)

Key:

Bold= Policy Question Plain text=Policy Adopted by the Council

Who is eligible to be a RAC member?

RACs should reflect the geographic, ethnic, and language diversity of the state, as described in statutes.

What about prior Area Board members?

Any Area Board member on December 31, 2014 may continue to serve on the RAC for that RO area until his/her term expires.

Who cannot be a member of a RAC?

Sitting SCDD Council members cannot be also be members of the RAC. Councilmembers from a region are required to participate in his or her local RAC.

Any member of a Regional Center Governing Board, or a committee of a Regional Center Governing Board (excluding Self-Determination Advisory Committees and Self-Advocate Advisory Committees), shall not be eligible to serve on a SCDD Regional Advisory Committee.

How many members will the RAC have?

The goal is for each RAC to have 9-15 members, based on need, geographic area covered, or population. The Council's Membership Committee may determine the total number between 9 and 15 based on need and recommendations from the Regional Office and RAC. The RACs that inherited more than 15 members may reach the maximum number through attrition as the initial members terms expire.

Should every county be represented?

The RAC should have at least one member from each county in the RAC's region.

Are there other limitations on membership?

Providers are allowed to be members of a RAC. Providers are not to be more than 25% of total RAC membership.

What's the self-advocate percentage representation on each RAC?

At least 35% of RAC members shall be self-advocates. At least 35% of RAC members shall be family-advocates. The remaining 30% shall be self-advocates, family advocates, or other.

Will there be term limits?

Each RAC member serves at the pleasure of the Council. Each individual is eligible for two 3-year terms. The term limits begin anew as of January 1, 2015

What is the attendance policy for RAC members?

If a member of a RAC has unexcused absences for more than 25% of the RAC meetings within a calendar year, the member shall be considered as having ceased to discharge the duties of RAC membership.

What about conflicts of interest?

While it is not anticipated that RAC members will be making governmental decisions, if that happens and an individual has a conflict, that individual is expected to not be a part of the conversation or decision for that item.

RAC Membership Appointments

- Each RAC and RO can forward names to the SCDD Membership Committee for consideration.
- Each RAC may have its own Membership Committee for purposes of identifying and recruiting potential members and referring them to SCDD Membership Committee for consideration of referral to the SCDD.
- The SCDD Membership Committee will create a standardized application form/process.
- The SCDD Membership Committee makes appointments to the RACs.

What are the officers of the RAC?

RAC members shall elect a Chair and a Vice Chair from among its membership. The role of the Chair and Vice Chair is to run the RAC meetings.

What subcommittees may a RAC have?

A RAC may convene a Membership Committee for the purpose of screening and making recommendations to the Council's Membership Committee on candidates for the RAC.

Member Conduct

Each member of a RAC shall comply with the Council's Zero-Tolerance Polices which include:

- Discrimination
- Drug Free Workplace Statement
- Sexual Harassment
- Unprofessional Conduct
- Workplace Violence Prevention

A copy of these policies will be provided to the member upon appointment.

What is the role of the RAC?

Per statute, the role of the RAC is to:

- Advise SCDD and its RO on local issues and identify and provide input regarding local systemic needs within its communities;
- Provide input and be a source for data for the SCDD to consider in the formulation of the state plan;
- Provide public information programs for consumers, families, professional groups, and the general public to increase professional and public awareness of areas identified within the state plan;
- Engage in other activities as requested by SCDD.

The RAC may make recommendations to the Council. The RAC may not take positions independent of the Council.

DRAFT Policy Questions About the Local Self-Determination Advisory Committees (SDAC)

Who is responsible for appointing Local SDAC members?

The regional center and the State Council on Developmental Disabilities (Council) shall each appoint one-half of the membership of the committee.

Who is eligible to be appointed by SCDD (Council) to a Local SDAC?

The Council may appoint regional center consumers, family members, other advocates, and community leaders.

What is the role of the Local SDAC?

Per statute, the role of the Local SDAC shall be to review the development and ongoing progress of the Self-Determination Program, including whether the program advances the principles of self-determination and is operating consistent with the requirements of this section, and may make ongoing recommendations for improvement to the regional center and DDS.

How many members will the Local SDAC have?

Each regional center shall determine the size of the Local SDAC.

Are there other limitations on membership?

A majority of the Local SDAC shall be consumers and their family members. The committee shall reflect the multicultural diversity and geographic profile of the catchment area.

Will there be term limits?

Each Council-appointed Local SDAC member serves at the pleasure of the Council. Each individual is eligible for two 3-year terms.

What is the attendance policy for Local SDAC members?

If a Council-appointed member of a Local SDAC has unexcused absences for more than 25% of the SDAC meetings within a calendar year, the member shall be considered as having ceased to discharge the duties of their membership.

What about conflicts of interest?

Members must recuse themselves from discussion and votes on any matter that would provide direct financial benefit to the member or otherwise give the appearance of a conflict of interest.

Member Conduct

Each Council-appointed member of a Local SDAC shall comply with the Council's Zero-Tolerance Polices which include:

- Discrimination
- Drug Free Workplace Statement
- Sexual Harassment
- Unprofessional Conduct
- Workplace Violence Prevention

A copy of these policies will be provided to the member upon appointment.

Local SDAC Council-Appointed Membership Process

- Candidates complete an online application which is forwarded to the SCDD Membership Committee for consideration.
- The Council's Membership Committee appoints applicants, regardless of whether a vacancy exists. If there is not a current vacancy, the selected candidate becomes active once a vacancy occurs on their local committee. In the interim, the candidate is encouraged to participate as members of the public to stay engaged.

I was in a wheel chair and could not leave my home without a service animal. Now, thanks in large part to self-determination and the team that I have been blessed with, I am out of that



wheel chair, i have the "episodes" only several times a month instead of a day and I can function. I served a full term, having been on the DDS CAC board for over 6 years. During my last few months with the committee, during which I was the president, we were presented with information about the aftermath of hurricane Katrina, and the things that had been done to people with developmental disabilities, their service animals, and the elderly. Due to this information, I was not even able to attend my last meeting as president. It was more than I could handle both mentally and emotionally. Now, over 15 years later, the person I am today, is nothing like the person I was. Self- Determination has helped me become a functioning member of society and I think not only can I help other people who may be new to SD, but i can provide a voice to those who need one. I have been with SD since the very beginning and was apart of the original team, that wrote the pamphlets, letters, books, and memos that were distributed state wide. I can and will be an asset to the SDAC. I have been developmentally disabled my entire life, with the last 20 years being spent in SD. I have been through everything. I want to help.

I have always wanted to help people and have always been drawn to those with developmental disabilities in particular. They have the ability to touch your heart in ways that no one else can and when people take the time, they are can teach us so much.

What are your areas of interest in the developmental disability field and service system?:

My interest in the developmental disability field has always been simple, I want to help. For the last 20 years, in one way or another I have worked with developmentally disabled adults and children, the elderly, and have been an advocate even when I didn't know that is what I was doing. I will be taking the upcoming IF training, in hopes to continue working with any i can help. I do not want to simply help the individual. I want to help their team. I bring with me extensive and varied experience and knowledge. I want to help, and I feel that I can by being apart of the SDAC, as well as continuing what i call working on



the front lines. I want to be a voice for not only the person with disabilities, but a voice for the team members who need one. Working with a person who has developmental disabilities is never about working solely with that person but with all those who are connected to them and helping to give the individual the best life that we can. How many nursing homes or group homes that I have worked with that have clients who would be a perfect fit for the SD program but do not know how to even apply? The individual I was a direct care provider for has been both sole employer and co employer. So, from a team members perspective, I have experience with both of those models. Also, I am not related to the participant in any legal way. She is now however, a permanent member of my family. This however has given me a working knowledge of things that a non-related team member might experience. I have taken and completed several semesters so far related to becoming a social worker, and have worked with many different agencies including but definitely not limited to DDS, IHSS, Adult and Aging Services both



statewide and county, DCFS (both in official and a personal capacity), and have in representation of my participant worked with police departments and the California judicial systems. My client is a unique person on every level possible. She attributes many of her achievements over the last 7 years to me and the things that I have been directly involved with for her. I see it as the other way around. Because of her, I have attained a knowledge and experience that can benefit many people. She is responsible for who she is today and how far she has come. I simply began working with the SD program to give her the building blocks to be the person she is today. My participant helped make me the person I am today. She was always an amazing, smart, and tough woman. She simply needed someone to love her and understand her enough to help her in her fight. I can and will be that for others both in the SD program and not, and really can help the SDAC in many ways.
