### 10. CONSIDER UPDATES TO THE RAC POLICY

Committee members reviewed staff recommendations to streamline the RAC appointment process by allowing appointments to the RACs regardless of vacancy status. By doing so, this would allow regional managers to immediately fill vacancies when needed. Regional managers would be responsible for notifying the Committee once the candidate is activated to ensure accurate record keep. This process is already being using for the Local SDACs.

It was moved/seconded (Ponton [SA]/Adler [SA]) and carried to move recommend that the Executive Committee adopt this process. (unanimous, see page one for members present.)


