What is CERT?

- CERT stands for Community Emergency Response Team
- Since 1993, CERT programs have prepared communities in basic disaster response skills to stay safe and save lives during disasters.
- Nationwide approach to volunteer training and organization that community members and professional responders can rely on during emergencies

What do they do?

- CERT teams perform basic response activities like checking in on neighbors, distributing information, and helping to manage traffic before, during, and after disasters.
- Their work frees up first responders to focus on more complex and/or dangerous efforts.

- Identifying and helping neighbors/coworkers that need assistance
- Distribute preparedness materials
- Staff first aid booths
- Assist with installation of smoke alarms
- Parade route management
