SDP Evaluation Survey by UCLA

- ▶ UCLA recently released a survey for Self-Determination Program participants
 - Satisfaction
 - Five SDP Principles:
 - Freedom
 - Authority
 - Support
 - Responsibility
 - Confirmation
- ▶ Collaboration with SCDD and DRC; survey aligned with the mandates included in statute

SDP Evaluation Survey by UCLA

- ▶ Values: independence, validated questions
 - Uses National Core Indicator validated questions
- ▶ Feedback from the community suggests revisions need to be made
 - Too long
 - Questions feel clinical
 - Terminology is national, not CA-specific
 - Should ask questions to promote the benefits of SDP

- ▶ **1,236 Total Participants**
(1,054 English, 169 Spanish, 13 Vietnamese)
- ▶ **935 Total Certificates Issued**
(828 English, 99 Spanish, 8 Vietnamese)

Good Balance

- ▶ Consumer 8%; Family 65%; Professionals 25%
- ▶ Latinx 12%; White 31%; API 19%; Black 8%; Declined 22%

Positive Response

- ▶ 95% found information useful
- ▶ 55% Plan to enroll in SDP
 - 30% Still considering it
