### Background

At the February 15, 2022, SSDAC meeting, the Committee participated in a survey to determine activity priorities. Results of the survey showed that the Committee's top priority was to develop a platform to share best practices.

# As of the last SSDAC meeting...

Co-Chairs and the SSDAC Workgroup worked with staff to:

- Create a Best/Promising Practice Submission Form
- Develop a webpage to host the Best/Promising Practices
- Send out an announcement and solicit submissions
- Provide a demonstration of how to use the submission form

# Since the last meeting...

The Best Practices Submission Form demonstration at the June SSDAC meeting produced good results.

- Received 21 best/promising practice submissions
  - 7 related to LVACs
  - 9 related to specific resources/trainings (Co-Chairs will follow up to review)
  - 4 recommended for deletion (incomplete/determined to not meet criteria)

Because so many submissions were related to LVACs, we have focused on developing that section of the platform first.
