#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

#### 5. APPROVAL OF JANUARY 22, 2024 MINUTES

Members reviewed the minutes from the January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024 meeting. The minutes can be found starting on page 7 of the March 2024 SAAC packet.

#### **ACTION 1**

It was moved/seconded (Witherspoon [SA]/ Ryan [SA]) and carried to approve the January 22<sup>nd</sup> minutes as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion.

#### 6. MEMBER UPDATES

Members shared their concerns about the ongoing need to promote inclusion of people with disabilities in all aspects of community living. Members emphasized the importance of getting involved in issues that are important to them. Members continue to want to see a greater awareness of the work that SCDD does. The topics of Self-Determination, mental health, marriage and benefits, cuts to services and supports, employment, emergency preparedness, transportation, and voting access were brought up by Committee members. Members shared concerns about possible budget cuts and their impact on supports and services for people with I/DD.

#### 7. STATEWIDE SELF-ADVOCACY NETWORK (SSAN) REPORT

SCDD SSAN Representative Alex Reyes provided a verbal report of the December SSAN Meeting.

### 8. REVIEW OF COUNCIL BUSINESS

SCDD Manager of State Plan and Self-Advocacy Rihana Ahmad asked for committee feedback on the plain language of three (3) Requests for Proposals (RFPs) under consideration by the Council. Members requested that the social isolation project also include an effort to help people who have restricted mobility and are unable to attend many inperson activities. Members shared concerns about connecting to advocates in both rural and urban settings.

#### 9. PERSON-CENTERED ADVOCACY VISION EDUCATION (PAVE) PROJECT

California Community Living Network (CCLN) Executive Officer Mark Melanson and Person-Centered Advocacy Vision Education (PAVE) Project Manager Dr. Julie Beadle Brown ask for Committee feedback on four (4) draft plain language resources under development related to four (4) regional center service codes: Supported Living, Independent Living, Respite, and Employment. Members shared concerns about how children with disabilities who have parents with disabilities would be able to access services and supports. Members were also concerned that the Employment resource did not include enough employment options.

#### SELF-ADVOCATES ADVISORY COMMITTEE STATE COUNCIL ON DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES Discussion: Mental Health Awareness, Available Supports and the Council's Work

Since 1949, the month of May has been recognized as Mental Health Awareness month to highlight how important mental health is to a person's overall well being. The Council has collected data, received individual stories from people, and documented the trend of an increase awareness of mental health challenges, including feelings of isolation, and lack of access to services and supports, for people with intellectual and developmental disamilities (I/DD) during the current 5-year State Plan.

This agenda Item will include an overview of some of the Councils efforts to address the mental health needs of Californians with I/DD.

Following an overview of Council's efforts, members will have a chance to participate in a conversation about access to mental health supports and services. Members are encouraged to share ideas about opportunities to strengthen support for people with I/DD in California during this agenda item.
