**Program Development Grants
(PDG) are used by the Council to:**

1. Meet federal and state requirements
2. Provide resources
3. Build new and innovative programs and services
4. Create important changes in systems that provide services, supports and training for people with I/DD and their families and those who serve them

Prior Council Actions:

- In March 2024, The Council approved Cycle 47 RFP's for:
 - ✓ Self-Advocacy (Plain Language)
 - ✓ Self-Advocacy (Social Isolation)
 - ✓ Tribal Health
- In July 2024, the Council acted to adopt the State Plan Committee Cycle 47 funding recommendations for two (2) projects in the amount of \$282,745.
- The Council also acted to authorize the Executive Committee to review and approve a Cycle 47 Tribal health RFP, subject to funding availability
