December 2024: Regional Center Performance Measures: Self-Determination Program (SDP) Incentive Payment




January 2025: Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Funding for Self-Determination Program

































Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Funding for SDP

Recruitment/Training of Person-Centered Planning and Self-Directed Support Providers (Fiscal year 2023-2024)


Increasing the number of available person-centered planning and SD Support providers. This could include, but is not limited to, recruitment, development and/or provision of training, translation/interpreters, etc.

➡ Employer Readiness Training/Workshops (Fiscal year 2024-2025)


Training for participants, families, and providers should focus on employer readiness, educating participants about their roles and responsibilities in the co-employer or sole employer model.




Implementation Funding by Regional Centers, FY 2021-22




Implementation Funding by Regional Centers, FY 2022-23




Implementation Funding by Regional Centers, FY 2023-24




