What is the State Plan?




The State Plan Is:

- 1) A contract between SCDD and the Administration on Community Living (ACL)
- 2) A strategic plan which guides the Council in carrying out its projects and activities across CA

How is the State Plan Designed & Structured?

- Through community input
- With measurable outcomes
- Divided into three goal areas:
 1. Self-Advocacy
 2. Systems Change
 3. Capacity-Building

State Plan Committee

The State Plan Committee is responsible for developing and reviewing the State Plan, monitoring its implementation, ensuring the completion of goals and objectives, and recommending areas of focus for grants and other activities.



Committee Responsibilities

State Plan Development:

- Establish State Plan Development Workgroup as needed
- Review State Plan Survey design and data collection plan
- Review collected data and analysis
- Develop goals and objectives for Council review/approval
- Review Public Comment on State Plan and adjust as needed

Monitoring and Reporting:

- Review mid-year and annual progress toward fulfillment of State Plan goals and objectives.
- Review the annual Program Performance Report (PPR) prior to submission to the Administration for Community Living (ACL)

Committee Responsibilities

Cycle Grant Request for Proposal (RFP) Development

- Recommend Cycle Grant focus areas for RFP's
- Review final RFP's and submit for Council review/approval

Grant Project Awards

- Review scoring team's recommendations and submit for Council review/approval

Monitor Cycle Grant Progress

- Review progress updates on Cycle Grant projects
